

Graduating Class of 2025

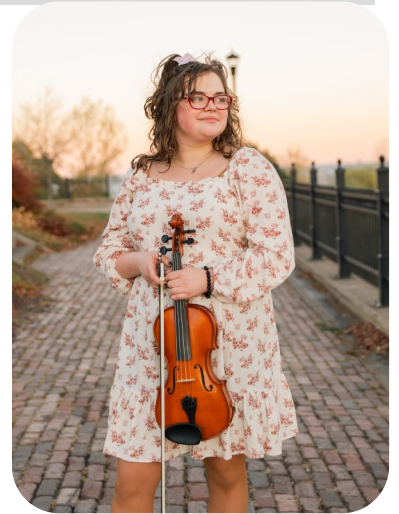
Bergen Hubley
