

Damiano Volunteer Instructions

The Community Kitchen is located on the lower level of the Damiano Center, 206 W. 4th Street. Volunteers should enter the door off the parking lot on the west side of the building. Ask the door attendant to let you into the lower level. If there is no door attendant, call 218-726-0500 and ask a kitchen employee to let you in.

Volunteers should wear a cap or hair covering or will be asked to use a hair net provided by the kitchen. Wear closed-toe shoes as well. Sign in on the iPad in the supply closet just off the kitchen and grab a clean apron. Wash your hands and put on a pair of disposable gloves. The 8:30-10:30am and 1:30-3:30pm shifts do food preparation: making salad, cutting up fruit, buttering bread, or bagging hardboiled eggs for breakfast bags. The 11:00am-1:00pm and 4:30-6:30pm shifts serve plates of food in a cafeteria-like line. Damiano staff are available during all shifts to give directions and answer questions.

Currently shifts are preparing for and serving between 200 and 250 plates/meal. Your sign up is an important and much appreciated part of Peace's ministry in the community. If you are not able to help at the time for which you signed up, please try to find a substitute from the group listing in Peace's Church Center app. If you cannot do that, please contact Charlotte Frantz (218-213-6873) or Diane Swanoski (218-213-8001).
